CORONAVIRUS

Concerning the measures taken by the government these past few days, we wanted to ensure clear and consistent communication with our customers regarding the mandatory protocols by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Caribe Glass Consulting has been actively following the guidelines and recommendations as outlined by the CDC, as well as the local and U.S. health authorities. Our personnel and all the subcontractors have been trained and informed about all the guidelines of how to prevent and protect themselves and others from Covid19.

Preventive measures taken by our teams:

- Wash hands often
- Avoid close contact and maintain recommended distancing
- Cover of mouth and nose with respirator mask
- Clean and disinfect
- Prepare a safe workspace area

Our protocol also includes a register form for each project visited during the day. Caribe Glass Consulting encourages all our customers to use respirator masks during any visit of our personnel or subcontractors to protect everyone in the household. The subcontractor will clean all tools and materials installed each day and the client will be responsible for cleaning and disinfecting the installed materials and areas in their facilities. Subcontractor can not leave any tools at any project. Caribe Glass Consulting is committed to following all measures recommended by the authorities to deal with this emergency.
